As informed earlier the date set for the HSSC Principals meet is set on Thursday, 28th June, 2018, at Hotel Green Park at 2pm through 5pm followed by high Tea. The Prime agenda is to present a round-up of the present committee's progress and to elect the new committee, 2018-2020.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

1. Nominate ONE member from your Cluster, by following pre-requisites:

b. Active and Capable member, representing the face of HSSC, who would possess minimum tenure of 2 years left before retirement.

c. Only Principal of a registered affiliated School at Hyderabad and having worked in the same School for a minimum of 5 yrs.

d. SCHOOL (of the Nominee) must show all dues cleared status (with HSSC membership).

e. Must be actively involved in attending all meetings in the HSSC in the past and also for the future.

f. Must be selected/ nominated with mutual CONSENSUS by all members of the Cluster.

g. Evidence of all the above factors will be verified by the old committee, hence the duly attested proof of evidences must be brought along by the CLUSTER Heads and shown to the core committee, during the meeting.

* All the details of the Final Election process will then be drafted out and explained to the CLUSTER HEADS and the nominated members on the 23rd June Meeting at Hotel GREEN PARK at 4pm...

Attendance is compulsory do please keep your date free..

* Request all CH take a consensus opinion of all members before arriving at the conclusion. There should not be any complain received from any member whatsoever indicating plagiarism or favouritism or bias...CHs please keep that in mind. On the final day, i.e. 28th June, a ballot paper will be released to all the the 7 nominated members who will then elect themselves through the ballot paper. The exact details will be shared on 28th June at 1pm at Hotel GREEN PARK.
